### **OPEN ENROLLMENT: February 17, 2026**

During open enrollment, the application link will be available under **International Visiting Student**, and an **Apply Now** button will appear in the top right corner of the website for all to easily access.

## Registration Steps

### 1. Complete the Berkeley Summer Sessions application

- Applicants must login or create an account to access the application.
- Submit documentation for the [English Proficiency Requirement](#) via the application unless exempt.
- [Verify identity](#) and pay the \$25 non-refundable application fee.

### 2. Establish CalNet ID and access CalCentral

- After completing the application, applicants will receive email instructions with their Student ID number within 2-3 days.
- For CalNet ID support, students may contact [calnet2-stephelp@berkeley.edu](mailto:calnet2-stephelp@berkeley.edu).

### 3. Enroll in [Classes](#) via Calcentral

- International students traveling on an F-1 student visa must be enrolled [full-time](#).
- Visiting students may enroll in any class with space available, as long as they meet any [prerequisites](#) and there aren't department restrictions. Courses fill on a first-come, first-served basis.

### 4. Submit I-20 Request via the International Student Services (ISS) Portal

- International students will have a CalCentral task item with a link to the I-20 request form.
- For any visa, I-20, or immigration questions, please contact [visiting-intl@berkeley.edu](mailto:visiting-intl@berkeley.edu).

### 5. Pay Total Balance

- Self-paying visiting students must pay the tuition and fees within 7 days of enrollment; otherwise, they will be dropped from all classes for non-payment.

### 6. Apply for [Housing](#)

- A variety of housing options are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

### 7. Check Berkeley Email Account REGULARLY

- All communications from Berkeley will be sent to the student's Berkeley email account.
