HONGIK UNIVERSITY RESIDENCE GUIDELINES - CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT –

1 HEALTH EXAMINATION

° RESULT OF TB TEST IN NEED FOR ALL DORMITORY RESIDENTS

- To ensure the University's public health, all students willing to live in the dormitory MUST take a health examination on TB (Tuberculosis), and submit the test result to the Dormitory Administration by the move-in date.
- Without the negative test result document, you will be rejected to enter the university dormitory. This is a measure taken for public health, and we ask for your understanding.
 - * TB test result must be written in English or Korean.
 - * TB test must be done within <u>3 months</u> from the move-in date.

2 RULES OF RESIDENCE AND CODE OF CONDUCT IN HU DORMITORY

- ° HU Dormitory Regulations * All residents must abide by the Dormitory Regulation throughout their stay
 - 1. The use of alcoholic beverages, smoking, gambling and cooking is prohibited inside the dormitory.
 - 2. Guests are only permitted after presenting their identification card or a name card. No mixed gender visits are permitted at any time under any circumstances.
 - 3. Damage to furnishings is considered to be the responsibility of the resident of that room. The resident of the room should be the one who is responsible for the cost of repair or replacement.
 - 4. No entrance is allowed after 24:00 AM under any circumstances. For a stay-out, you must prereport it to the dormitory administration office.
 - 5. Residents are fully responsible for any case of damage, robbery or loss of personal belongings.
 - 6. Individual or group activities that can result in unsanitary conditions are prohibited.
 - * If you violate any of the rules stated above or receive warnings from facility staffs more than three times, you will be discharged immediately. Any student expelled from the dormitory for violating the rules will not receive a refund.

° Guideline for HU Dormitory Reward & Penalty Points * no exception

Residents whose penalty point reach 7 points in total, must leave the dormitory immediately. Residents whose penalty point reach 5 points in total can be put on a probation.

[+2 Reward Points]

Residents who

- 1. have been selected as best practices
- 2. have been awarded for good deeds
- 3. have received approval for reporting violations of the regulation that fall under immediate leave (forced move-out)

[Immediate Leave (Forced Move-out)]

Residents who

- 1. have been suspended from Hongik University
- 2. have carried out or been involved in a burglary, arson attack, gambling, or any acts of violence
- 3. have caused damage to the dormitory property or facilities
- 4. have caused sleep disturbance to other residents in the dormitory
- 5. have continued or led collective (group) action irrelevant to maintenance of order
- 6. have allowed or assisted outsiders (non-residents) to enter or stay in the dormitory
- 7. have accessed to unauthorized emergency or fire exits
- 8. have drunk alcoholic beverage or smoked in the dormitory
- 9. have entered into or stayed at the opposite gender's dormitory room
- 10. have acted as a proxy
- 11. have cooked or possessed burner (or any other heating cooking devices) in the dormitory
- 12. have possessed or distributed prohibited drugs or any other controlled substance
- 13. have lent access card to others
- 14. have not either vacated room by the informed move-out date or abided by the move-out procedure
- 15. have changed room without permission

[-5 Penalty Points]

Residents who

- 1. have entered or assisted others (non-residents) to enter the dormitory room without permission
- 2. have violated regulations for using the dormitory lounge or linen room
- 3. have carried in or used any flammable or hazardous materials
- 4. have used unauthorized electric heating appliances
- 5. have moved or transformed dormitory facilities without permission
- 6. have disobeyed or rebelled against legitimate instructions from the dormitory supervisors

[-3 Penalty Points]

Residents who

- 7. have posted without permission
- 8. have displayed or distributed advertisements without permission

[-2 Penalty Points]

Residents who

- 9. have entered into or went to bed in a room other than one's own
- 10. have not responded to a roll-call
- 11. have made a room or public facilities unclean
- 12. have not tidied a room up and made it to be in a poor condition
- 13. have caused disturbance or noise
- 14. have stayed out overnight without permission
- 15. have caused inconvenience to others or damage to the dormitory
