#### Eligibility


- Students currently enrolled in an accredited college/university

- · Copy of Passport
- Proof of Health Insurance (only for students enrolled in in-person courses)
- Consent Letter signed by a legal guardian (only for pre-college students)

#### Application Procedures

- Complete the online application form at winter2.korea.ac.kr.
   (course selection to be completed through the online application form)
- 2. Pay the application fee of KRW 100,000 (non-refundable)
- 3. Send the required documents to kuwinter@korea.ac.kr
- 4. Receive the 'Letter of Acceptance'
