Cost	MIX works with three types of students: Exchange Students (tuition waiver), Hoakipa Visiting Students (fee-paying with discount), and Independent Visiting Students (full fee-paying). Students must also budget for health insurance, special course fees, books and supplies, housing, meals, local transportation, and personal expenses.

Visa and Immigration	
Visa	A student who is not a U.S. citizen or permanent resident (resident alien), will need a F-1 student visa in order to study at UHM as an exchange or visiting student. More details can be found on the UHM ISS website: https://www.hawaii.edu/issmanoa/?page_id=18 . A Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20) will be issued to participants upon admission into the program.
Employment	Exchange and visiting students may work on campus during their program dates, limited to 20 hours per week during academic semesters. However, participants in Mānoa International Exchange (MIX) programs cannot engage in F-1 Practical Training, including CPT, OPT, or internships. Arrival	
Key Requirements	All incoming international students are required to complete a health clearance process, immigration course, and obtain health insurance coverage that meets the minimum requirements of the university. Failure to complete these requirements by the given deadlines may result in serious repercussions. Arrival Dates	Students should aim to arrive around one week before classes start to join MIX and ISS welcome activities, attend New Student Orientation, and complete health clearance and immigration processes. Students are not allowed to arrive after the first day of class without prior approval by MIX staff.
