## INCOMING STUDENT QUOTA

Length of the study abroad/exchange period at Temple: one (1) year or one (1) semester

- **Study Abroad:** Typically, up to 10 students from one institution at any given time
- **Exchange:** Typically 4 semesters per academic year (Fall-Spring)\*

Spring deadline: October 15

### Application Process

1. Home university nominates student
2. Global Programs contacts student with application link and instructions
3. Student creates online account, completes application and submits supplemental documents online
4. Global Programs reviews application
5. Global Programs sends electronic acceptance packet to student

### Supplemental Application Documents:

- List of current semester courses
- Official language scores
- Course registration process form
- Official transcript(s)
- Housing agreement form (if applicable)
- I-20 application (after acceptance)
  - Financial documentation
  - Copy of biographical page of passport



# ADMISSION CRITERIA

## Undergraduate (bachelor's) students

- Must have completed at least 2 semesters of **full-time** study at home university before studying at Temple
- **GPA:**
  - Exchange Applicants: 3.00/4.00
  - Study Abroad/Fee-Paying Applicants: 2.50/4.00
- **English requirements:** TOEFL (79 iBT, 550 ITP), IELTS (6.0), Duolingo English Test (110), CEFR (B2), or TOEIC Listening & Reading Test (390 in each section)\*

## Graduate (master's) students

Varies by academic program, please contact us for more details regarding master's students. PhD students are not eligible to study at Temple on exchange.

\*English language instruction is available through the Temple Center for English Language and Culture and may be required for students who do not meet minimum language requirements: <https://tcalc.temple.edu/>

# SEMESTER DATES

Orientation takes place during the week before classes begin. Students will be notified of arrival dates after acceptance. Tentative dates of the upcoming academic year at Temple University:

- Fall 2026 semester starts August 24, 2025 and ends December 15, 2026.
- Spring 2027 semester starts January 11, 2027 and ends May 4, 2027.

FEES	\$528 University Services Fee (study abroad students only); \$175 International Student fee (all students); Course-specific fees may apply
